- 1. Applicants submit plans to the Physical Planning Department for approval to ensure that the construction is in keeping with their guidelines for the accommodation sector.
- 2. Complete Hotel Construction Approval Order form from the Ministry of Tourism, Sports and Culture.
- 3. Submit to the Ministry of Tourism, Sports and Culture completed **Construction Approval Form**, **Approved Plans and Certificate** from Physical Planning Department, also a **list of items** with **description** and **quantity** that will be used during the construction phase.
- 4. Ministry of Tourism, Sports and Culture prepares Cabinet memorandum and submits to the Ministry of Finance and the Attorney Generals' Chambers for financial and legal implications.
- 5. Upon receipt of these implications Ministry of Tourism, Sports and Culture further submits memo for Cabinet's approval.
- 6. Applicant is informed of Cabinet's decision.
- *Please note that the applicant will be exempted from **VAT** and **Customs Duty**.
- * Nationals must construct a minimum of five (5) rooms and foreigners a minimum of ten (10) rooms.
